



This policy governs all non-uniform wearing College events and has been prepared to provide guidance for parents, staff and students as regards student dress when non-school uniform items are worn. It applies on occasions like excursions, camps, out-of-school hours visits or events, Casual Days, College Formal and any other occasion when students are not wearing school uniform, but are participating in a school activity both during or after school hours.

Enforcement of this policy is at the discretion of the College. Students who are deemed to be in breach of the policy will not be allowed to attend the planned activity and will either remain at school or parents contacted and the student sent home. Should a dispute arise, then the student is not to participate in the activity and the matter is to be referred to the College Board.

BOYS

- 1 Neat casual clothing or formal wear as appropriate is expected such that students maintain Biblical standards of modesty.
- 2 The following items are NOT to be worn:
 - (a) No tank tops
 - (b) No clothing that is excessively tight
 - (c) No clothing which is torn or in a state of disrepair
 - (d) No clothing with images that are not in line with the College's Biblical Worldview including rock-bands or offensive slogans
- 3 For swimming, board shorts and a dark coloured t-shirt/rashy are to be worn at all times, in or out of the water
- 4 Jewellery may only be worn as per the Uniform Policy
- 5 Appropriate footwear is to be worn – **no thongs (unless permission is given in writing for that activity by the appropriate Deputy Principal)**

GIRLS

- 1 Neat casual clothing and formal wear as appropriate is expected such that students maintain Biblical standards of modesty.
- 2 The following items are NOT to be worn:
 - (a) No mini-skirts or shorts where the length above the knee is greater than 10 cm when standing (not short shorts)
 - (b) No clothing that is excessively tight
 - (c) No halter tops, tank tops, low cut tops or tops which result in a bare midriff
 - (d) No clothing which is torn or in a state of disrepair
 - (e) No clothing with images that are not in line with the College's Biblical Worldview including rock-bands or offensive slogans
 - (f) No leggings / jeggings– unless worn with a skirt or dress of at least as per dot point (a).
- 3 For swimming, board shorts and a dark coloured T-shirt must be worn over the top of bathers.
- 4 Jewellery may only be worn as per the Uniform Policy
- 6 Appropriate footwear is to be worn - **no thongs (unless permission is given in writing for that activity by the appropriate Deputy Principal)**
