Notes for Exams & Work Sessions

- All exams are in the Library or L3 [Lib or L3] unless otherwise indicated.**
- Students are required to wear full school uniform** (not sports uniform or tracksuits) during exams and at all other times when attending school, as well as to and from school. Students will not be allowed to enter the exam room or work session if they are not in full school uniform.
- The programme for Weeks 8-9 for Years 10-12 students is listed on the attached timetable. Students who do not have an exam or work session scheduled are required to **stay at home** to study. Students who need to come to school (for transport or other reasons) **must be involved in productive, quiet study**. If working at school, only Year 12 students may go over to the shopping centre to buy recess and/or lunch at the designated times but must return to school to eat it and must sign in and out at the School Office. This relates to the school's legal 'duty of care' and is for your safety and protection.
- Any student who is unable to attend an exam or work session must inform the School Office as soon as possible. A Medical Certificate will be required to confirm any medical problems, otherwise students will receive an exam mark of 0 (zero).
- Any student who is late for an exam or work session must report to the School Office before going to the required room. Unless a reasonable excuse is given, no catch-up time will be allocated.
- The exam room will be opened 15 minutes before the starting time of the exam. Students are requested to be seated **no later than 10 minutes before** the commencement of the exam.
- Students are expected to be considerate of others whilst exams are in progress. There is to be no communicating with another student during an exam. Any student breaching exam conduct rules will be subject to the following consequences:
 - First offence* - Verbal warning, name recorded by supervisor on roll.
 - Second offence* - Written warning on student's exam paper.
 - Third offence* - Removal from the Exam Room and an exam mark of 0 (zero).
- Students may not leave the exam before the published finishing time.** If students finish their exam before the allocated time, they should quietly check and edit their responses.
- A small portion of food is permitted (e.g. fruit, lollies, chocolate, etc...), and WATER.
- BAGS are not permitted next to you in the exam room and must be stored neatly at the back of the room.
- Students must abide by the Mobile Phone Policy. Phones must be placed on the front bench at the beginning of an exam. Any phone that is seen being used or that "rings", vibrates or does a jig during the exam will be immediately confiscated.
- Students are usually required to bring their own paper, calculators and pens/pencils/erasers to the exam.
- Students will not be allowed to visit the toilets during the course of an exam except in the case of an emergency and they should, therefore, plan this aspect of their exam attendance. Time missed in lieu will not be added to the end of the exam session unless a Medical Certificate specifies a medical condition.
- Students are encouraged to use the time between exams wisely to study. It is very unwise to arrange major recreational activities during this time. It might also be wise to inform employer(s) of your exam commitments, and request a reduction in hours for the duration of exams.
- SPECIAL PROVISIONS:** Students who are granted special provisions (extra time, use of a computer, etc.) will typically complete their exams in a separate, supervised room.
- Check the schedule for 10PLP Interviews. Look carefully at the time set aside either by Mrs DeGraaf or Mrs Fuller.**
- Wednesday to Friday of Week 9 = Compulsory attendance for Year 12 students, who will continue with their studies. Monday 9am session is also compulsory.**
- Thursday and Friday of Week 9 = Compulsory attendance for Years 10-11 students, who will partake of a special programme.**
- Week 10 = SEMESTER 2. Normal lessons. Compulsory attendance for all students.**
