Of those eligible, 100% of students achieved their SACE (South Australian certificate of Education), which is significantly above the state average for this statistic.

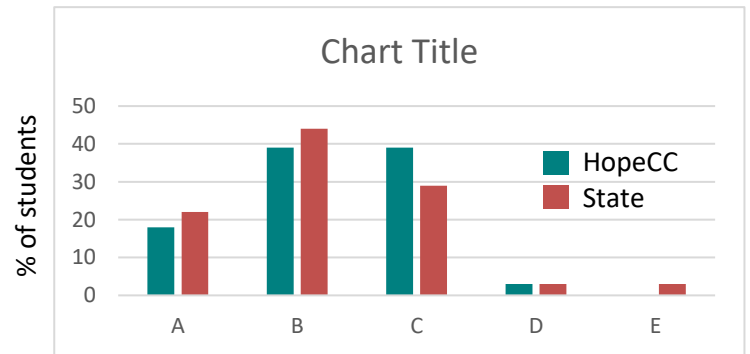
