

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

The Police Commissioner has just announced that South Australia is going into a 6 day lockdown, with the possibility of a further 8 day extension.

Hope Christian College and the OSHC service will be closed from Thursday 19 November (tomorrow) to all students except those of essential workers according to this list below of essential industries. Students will be able to return on Wednesday 25 November unless further restrictions come into force.

- Water
- Power
- Communications
- Supermarkets
- Medical works
- Public Transport
- Freight
- Petrol stations
- Some parts of the mining industry

If you are not an essential worker on the list, you cannot send your children to school. If you do send them we will send them home.

Junior School:

- Children will receive some work to take home. This work will not be sent back to school after the lockdown.

Middle School

- All course work will continue according to the timetable. Teachers will be available when normal lessons are timetabled by email, SEQTA and some Zoom lessons. Teachers will advise of this by email.
- Teachers will take a roll for each class attendance online.

Senior School

- Years 10 and 11 students must finish off all assignment work and email to teachers by the set due dates. Some students will be required too attend on Thursday next week (November 26) more details regarding this will be sent soon.
- There will be no Years 10 and 11 Senior School exams – these are cancelled

Students of essential workers according to the list may come to school tomorrow. Gates will be open at normal times for an 8:40am start. Students of essential workers will be doing online learning in the classroom. There will not be direct face-to-face teaching. There will only be online learning.
