Hope Christian College sent a team of 50 to the SA Athletics Stadium in Mile End on the 26th March 2021, to compete against other SACSA schools, but these students were more than athletes. Hope Christian College broke 30 athletic records on their way to victory, defeating schools like Southern Vales and Portside. The margin of victory was infinitesimal. *Only three points*. Extra volunteers are currently


